

SILVER SERVICE comes to an end. After 26 months of project implementation and full engagement of all project partners, the Silver Service project will end on 30th of November 2021. The last months of the project have been very busy for all partners to finalise the core project outputs, test them with target group representatives and provide them on the

SILVER SERVICE e-Learning Platform, for free download and further use.

During the last months and autumn 2021 the Silver Service project partners organised two **learning, teaching and training events** (Rome 10/2021 and Nikosia 11/2021) where all the outputs and especially IO4 Train the Trainer Programme and IO5 Induction Training Programme for Senior Volunteers were tested and finalised.

After its translation into all partner languages, the whole collection of materials for senior volunteers and their task of migrant integration support, psychographic profiling tools as well as the toolbox of learning resources are all available for download and further use via the project website and the e-learning platform developed.

On the **29th of November** the project partners organised a **final online multiplier event** and project results' presentation for a broader community of stakeholders and potential users. During this online event (due to the effects of the Covid 19 pandemic) the main results were shown and discussed with participants to kick off a process of broad and sustainable use of results after the project has ended.
